Our Beliefs

Antioch Baptist Church of Clinton is a, fundamental, Bible believing Church. We seek to be identified with those who love God's work and strive to practice it. We not only believe the fundamentals of the faith, but we take our stand against all things which discredit and try to destroy the authority of the Bible.

We believe that the Bible is the complete revelation from God and its contents are verbally inspired. We believe in the full inspiration of the word of God and it is our source of faith, practice and the final authority in all spiritual matters. **II Tim. 3:16, 17; II Peter 1:19, 21; Rev. 22:18, 19**

We believe that God is supreme in His person, eternal in His being, absolute in His attributes, glorious in His perfection, and sovereign in His will. God is clearly distinguished from things which have life, or no life. God is the creator of man and the universe and upholds all by the word of His power. We believe in the Holy Trinity, the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost. **I John 5:7.**

We believe that man was created in the image of God and by his own choice and willful decision, fell into sin. By this act, he became a sinner and was put under the condemnation of God. He was severed from God and became spiritually dead. **Gen. 1:26; Gen. 3:19; Rom. 6:23; Rom. 3:23.**

We believe salvation to be by grace through faith, wholly apart from any merit of man: and that every individual is a sinner by birth and by choice, and therefore must exercise repentance which is voluntary turning from sin; and personal faith, a voluntary turning to the redeeming work of Christ on Calvary's Cross in order to be saved. **Eph. 2:8, 9; Titus 3:5; Psalms 51:5; Rom. 10:9, 10; 3:10, 23, 24-28; 6:35**

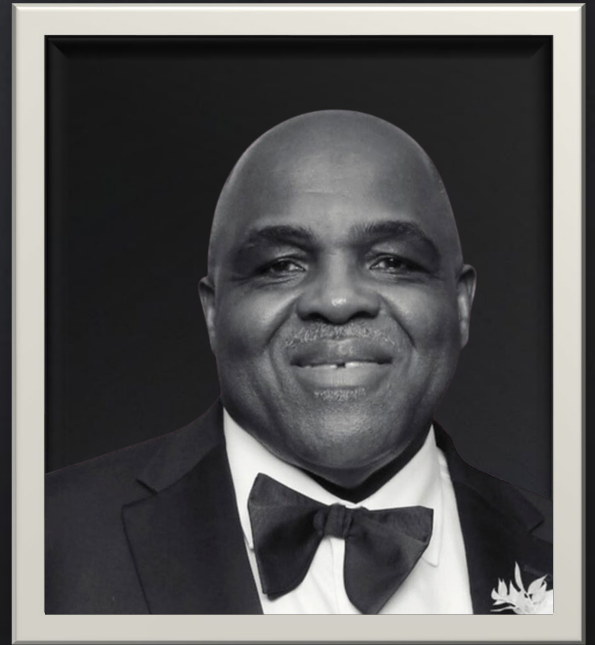

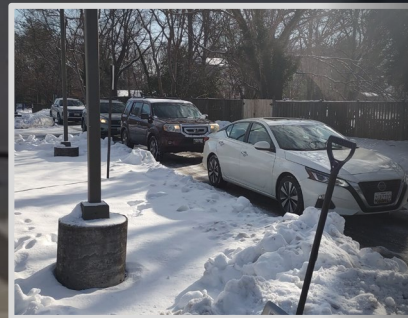

The Antioch Food Pantry

The Food Pantry celebrated its Fourth Year Anniversary on October 26, 2024, at our annual Harvest Festival event. Due to the continuing high cost of food more families are at risk of food insecurity. Our pantry has continued to make a difference in the lives of diverse families in Prince Georges County. We operated uninterrupted even during inclement weather, without a large grant from our Capital Area Food Bank partner and with the reduction in the availability of produce. Despite those circumstances, in 2024 we distributed over 50,000 pounds of food that includes 20,000 pounds of fresh produce served to patrons that made over 6,000 visits to our food pantry last year. In addition, we provide food to those in need on an emergency basis in between distribution dates. We have a growing email list of over 880 families that have visited our food pantry. Our food boxes include frozen meats, fresh produce and shelf stable items without income restriction or cost to recipients. We will continue to cultivate more resources and connect with families in need during these financially challenging times. Proverbs 22:9 KJV "He that hath a bountiful eye shall be blessed; for he giveth of his bread to the poor."
